This study sought to discover the meaning of aging through the phenomenological analysis of 58 elderly people from Manizales, Colombia. The study was guided by the Theory of Human Being, conceived by Heidegger, which aims to describe the meaning of human existence, and includes three elements: being-in-the-world, being-with-others, and being-for-self. As a study method,

a phenomenological methodology was used, in which the elderly were interviewed in their homes. The results showed that the elderly had a variety of attitudes to aging, depending on their previous life experiences. The participants generally tended to associate aging with declining physical health and facing life's realities.
